Summary of Discussions – Key Issues & Sand Movements

Ministerial Feasibility Studies – Regarding 2A/2B dredging placements the Governments are looking at the approval requirements under State and Federal Legislation. Governments working through final processes to asses benefit and risk of backpassing.

Advisory Committee Member Reports – Duranbah placement should be brought forward to September/October. An escarpment has been present at Kirra for some time, would a placement at Kirra be considered in the near future. Congestion between surfers and swimmers is being experienced at Rainbow Bay and sand movement toward Currumbin Creek requires pro-active management education.

Environmental Monitoring Overview – Overview presented and results around Kirra Reef were encouraging.

Sand Placement – The Target Quantity for pumping and dredging in Contract Year 14 is 375,000m³, comprised of delivery to Snapper Rocks East and Duranbah. Kirra will be discussed at the next meeting. Placement to be made to Duranbah in March/April, could be up to 30,000m³.
