

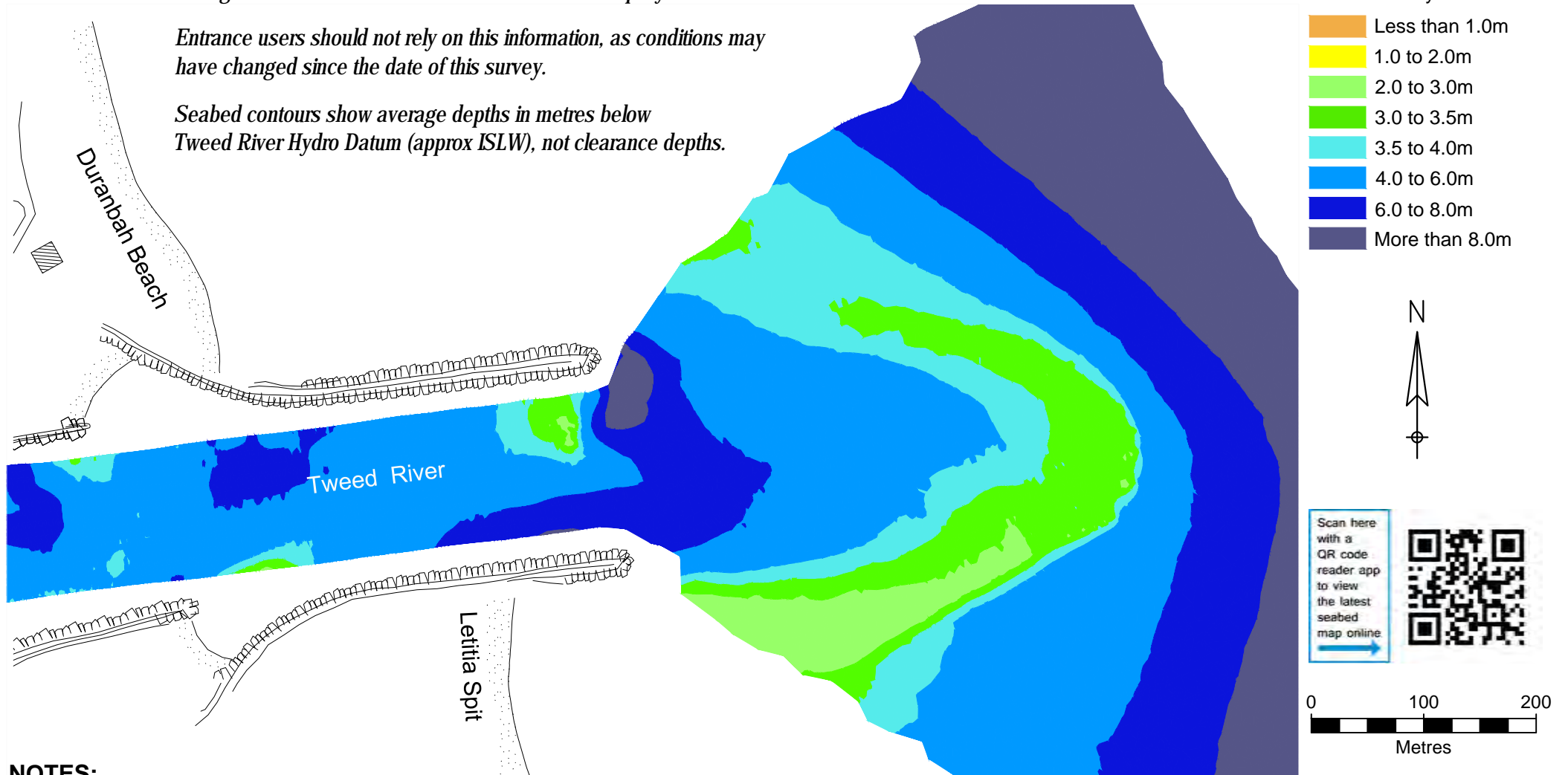
# TWEED RIVER ENTRANCE AS AT 5 OCTOBER 2016

**WARNINGS:** *Extreme caution should be used when navigating this entrance.*
