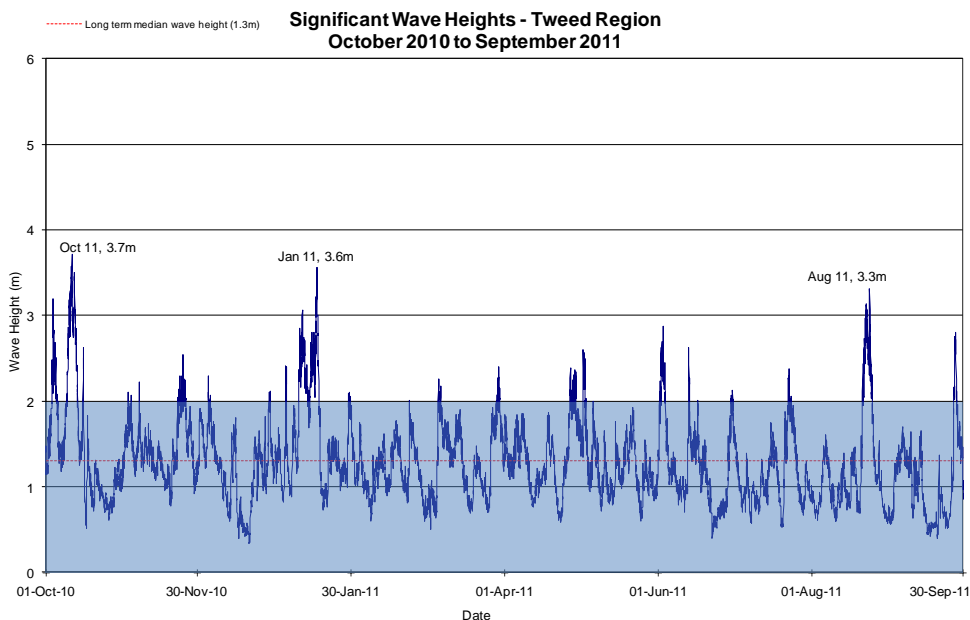


Note: The significant wave height is defined as the average height of the highest one-third of waves recorded over a period of typically 15 minutes.

2009 – 2010

Calm Year

- 1 minor storm (>3m)
- Few moderate seas (>2m)

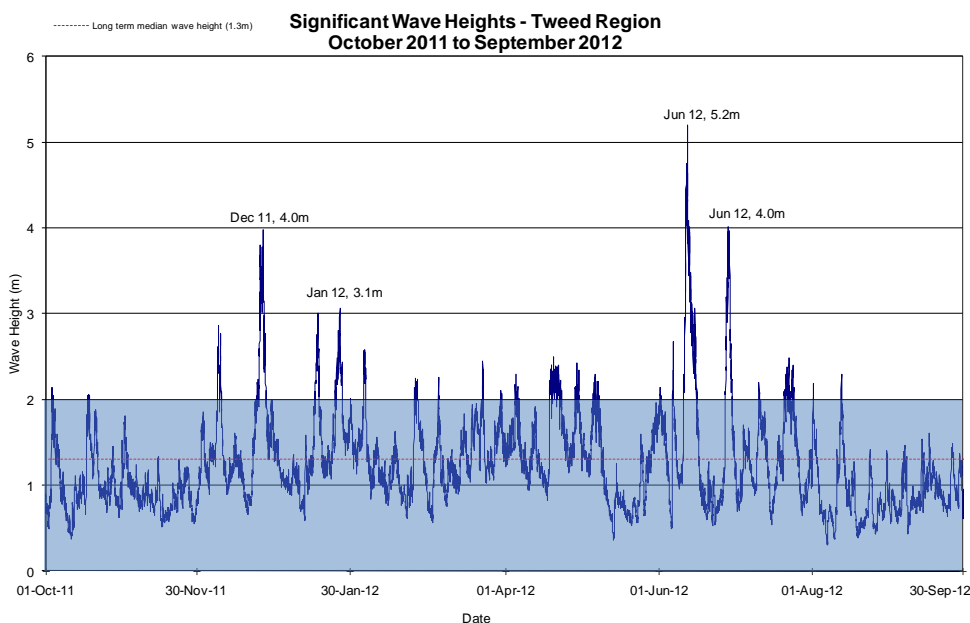

2010 – 2011

Typical Year

- 3/4 minor storms (>3m)
- Significant moderate seas (>2m)

2011 – 2012

Stormy Year

- 1 severe storm (>5m) approx. 1:4 yr
- 2 major storms (>4m) 1:1 yr
- 2/3 minor storms (about or >3m)
- Significant moderate seas (>2m)
